Rules

1. Entries through Equo events or by post and bank transfer to club account as per entry table below.
2. Rosettes will be awarded 1st – 6th
3. 2 bridle or saddle cloth numbers must be worn.
4. **Horse and rider combinations can only compete at one level to ensure we comply with COVID bubbles.**
5. **Scores will be displayed on the club facebook page at the end of the competition. Scoresheets can be posted, please leave an SAE, or a copy sent via social media after the competition.**
6. **We will be operating a track and trace procedure and only 1 additional person may accompany any competitor, who will be able to assist their rider to mount, thereafter will need to leave the warm up area. Only horse and rider are permitted in the warm up and competitor helpers must not stand at the entrance door.**
7. **Warm up will be limited.**
8. **Masks are to be worn at all times for those not mounted.**
9. British Dressage rules apply. However for this competition, rider competition wear will be relaxed although must be smart.
10. Any complaints must be made to the Competition Secretary before the completion of the class in question namely Leigh McEwan.
11. For all dressage tests whips may be carried, commanders are permitted and trot can be carried out in sitting or rising. Double bridles are permitted at Elementary or above.
12. Parents/guardians of anyone under the age of 18 should specify if they do not wish their child/children to be photographed by or in relation to Stonehaven & Area Riding Club.
13. At or in the vicinity of any S&ARC Riding Club event, everyone mounted, whether competing or not must wear a hard hat conforming to the minimum safety standards, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Failure to do so will incur elimination of the horse and/or rider from the competition. Where a hat is of skull cap style, this must be worn with a plain silk. Juniors under 18, it is advised that a hard hat be worn whilst on competition grounds.
14. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:** Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organizers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organizers of any event to which these rules apply, nor the British Horse Society, nor the agent, employee, or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
15. Competitors are required to show courtesy towards others when warming up. If riding on the opposite rein to one another competitors should pass left shoulder to left shoulder.
16. All horses and ponies known to kick out must wear a red ribbon on their tail and please make others aware whilst warming up.
17. The organisers reserve the right to decline any entry, combine, divide or cancel any class, if there are insufficient entries.
18. The club will not be held responsible for any complaint regarding horses or ponies entered in the wrong classes but will act as a mediator provided the complainer has proof on the day of the show.
19. All withdrawals Monday prior to the competition, later withdrawals will be charged.
20. Times will be available on the S&ARC Riding Club Facebook page [on the Tuesday before the competition.](#)
21. Due to covid no dogs are permitted.
22. The making of an entry implies acceptance of the conditions above.
23. All Classes will be split into Juniors & Adults.
24. All droppings and litter to be removed failure to do so shall result in name and shame!
